I hereby declare that to the best of my knowledge the above mentioned resident mare is not suffering from any contagious disease likely to be a risk to the stallion at the stud, and that neither she nor the stud have had any contact or exposure to strangles during the past two years.

No EHV-1 virus abortions, cases of strangles, stillbirths or relevant contagious diseases (e.g. EVA, EIA, CEM, Influenza, Salmonellosis, Dourine, etc.) have occurred within the last six weeks, nor are any such cases currently under investigation other than those who have received total clearance from the appropriate authorities.

[] Any mare arriving from ITALY *or* from outside the UK & Ireland and who has been in ITALY since 1 January 2011 will require two negative blood test results the first to be taken within 28 days prior to arrival in the UK taken on
[] and a second taken at the boarding stud a minimum of 14 days after arrival in the UK taken on.....

[] Mares already in the UK or Ireland who have been in ITALY since 1 January 2011 will require a single negative blood test for Dourine taken a minimum of 14 days after their arrival in UK or Ireland taken on.....

Copies of international travel documents should accompany the mare when visiting the stallion stud. Please refer to the HBLB Code of Practice 2012 for further details.

This declaration must accompany the mare at the time of EACH INDIVIDUAL COVERING or **PREFERABLY be faxed or posted to the Stud Office *before the mare arrives.***

CHECKLIST - BEFORE YOUR MARE ARRIVES AT THE STUD, PLEASE MAKE SURE WE HAVE RECEIVED:

For Mares which have not been outside the UK and Ireland within the last 12 months:

- Signed Nomination Agreement
- Completed & Signed Mare Particulars Form.
- Negative CEM Clitoral Swab certificate taken after 1st January 2012
- Negative EVA certificate taken after 1st January 2012
- Negative EIA (Coggins) Certificate taken after 1st January 2012
- Signed Veterinary Agreement (*not required for "walk-in" mares*)
- Negative CEM Endometrial (Cervical) Swab certificate taken during current oestrus period (*"Walk-in" mares only – boarding mares will be tested at the stud before covering*)
- Signed Freedom from Infection Certificate
- Passport (to arrive with the mare) showing updated influenza vaccination record *and photocopy of front page and identification page if possible for "walk-in" mares*

For Mares which have been outside the UK & Ireland within the last 12 months:

- Signed Nomination Agreement
- Completed & Signed Mare Particulars Form.
- Negative CEM Clitoral Swab certificate taken after 1st January 2012
- Negative EVA Certificate taken within 28 days of arrival in UK, plus 2nd test to be taken on arrival at UK stud (see overleaf)
- Signed Veterinary Agreement.
- Signed Freedom from Infection Certificate
- Passport (to arrive with the mare) showing updated influenza vaccination record
- Negative EIA Certificate - taken within 14 days of arrival in mainland Britain plus 2nd & possible further tests to be taken on arrival at UK stud (see over) **Plus** foal certificate if arriving from Italy.
- Negative Dourine Certificate(s) if mare been in Italy since 1 January 2011 (see over)
